The annual salary range for this position is currently \$208,644 to \$221,364 (increasing to \$228,000 July 1, 2023). Actual salary will be dependent upon the qualifications of the successful candidate. The District provides Management Incentive Pay of \$12,350 annually (increasing to \$13,000 effective July 1, 2023). Additionally, the District provides an excellent benefits package.
